Who are single parents and their families?

More and more these days parents find themselves raising their children alone, by themselves as single parents. There are more single parents raising their children now than ever before. The traditional structure of husband, wife and children is giving way to another form of family life – *“the single-parent family”*. Where one parent, either a mother or a father is forced for whatever reason to become the sole head of the household for their children.

The following statistics may surprise you. The number of single mothers increased between 1994 and 2006, from 3 million to 10.4 million; over the same time frame, the number of single fathers increased also, from 393,000 to 2.5 million.

33 % of all children in the United States that are under 18 years of age live in families where only one parent resides in the home (that's 1 in 3).

Of children living with one parent:

- 38% live with a divorced parent
- 35% live with a never-married parent
- 19% live with a separated parent
- 4% live with a widowed parent
- 4% live with a parent whose spouse lives elsewhere

Being a single parent is no walk in the park. It doesn't matter how one becomes a single parent.

The following statistics may surprise you.

In the United States

69 % are Two parent households
31 % are now Single parent households (That's 1 in 3)

In Mississippi

44 % are Single parent families (That's almost half)
Each year the percentage of single parent household's **continues to grow.** •

Of Single Parents

1994 - 2006

84% are single parent MOMS (from 3 million to 10.4 million)
16% are single parent DADS (from 393,000 to 2.5 million)

75 % of all children in the U.S. will spend at least some time in a single-parent household.

38.5% of all births in the U.S. are to unmarried women

Statistics—Marrying Again

38% of all weddings in the U.S. are remarriages for one or both partners. Most form step-families.
33% of individuals who got divorced in 2008 were re-divorcing (that is divorcing again).
33% of step-family marriages last until death do we part.
Over 60% of re-marriages end in divorce. Subjecting children to yet another family failure.
73% of third marriages end in divorce.
